Guidelines for Lateral Admission of BS-MS (Dual Degree) students into the Ph.D. programme at IISER Bhopal

1) Students who have completed four years of BS-MS (Dual Degree) program at IISER Bhopal

- a. with an aggregate CPI > 8 at the end of 8^{th} semester and
- b. with a CPI > 8 in their major subject (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology) at the end of 8^{th} semester

will be eligible to apply for lateral admission to the Ph.D. program at the end of their BS-MS degree.

For entry to the Ph.D. program in Earth and Environmental Sciences (EES) a 5th year student must have an overall CPI > 8 and a minor in EES at the end of 8th semester.

In addition to the above, individual departments may impose additional requirements (e.g. minimum grade that should be obtained in professional courses of that particular discipline chosen by the concerned student).

- 2) There can be additional departmental screening in the form of interview(s). The timing of conducting this screening/selection process is left to the discretion of individual departments.
- 3) The departments will intimate the list of selected candidates to the Academic Section on or before the end of mid-semester break of the 10th semester of that particular batch.
- 4) For candidates shortlisted thus for lateral admission, the last date for fee submission shall be the same as that for external candidates in that year.
- 5) The candidates admitted to the Ph.D. program through this mode of entry should complete a minimum of 16 credits through course-work within the first two semesters of the program.
- 6) The protocol for allotting a guide will be decided by individual departments.
- 7) Financial support shall commence from the date of registration into the Ph.D. program and the support shall be at par with that given to institute fellows. However, if a lateral entry student chooses to commence his research work following the completion of the BS-MS program, he/she shall be paid arrears for the duration of his stay prior to registration.

Each Department shall send a list of lateral entry students eligible for arrears along with the duration of arrears due to the academic office within two weeks of Ph.D. registration.

- 8) Each department should preferably limit the intake of Ph.D. students through this mode to around 30%. Thus, depending on the number of sanctioned Ph.D. positions, each department should declare the number of positions available for lateral admission that year.
- 9) Each department should get the specific criterion for admission and the proposed number of students for lateral admission confirmed/modified by the Senate before the end of each academic year.
