Notification

In view of the present level of uncertainty caused by the Covid-19 pandemic worldwide, the academic schedule for the rest of the present semester (2019-2020-II Semester) needs to be revised. After several rounds of discussions, following decisions have been taken, keeping in mind the health and wellbeing of our students, quality of education and career plans of graduating students:

- The summer vacation period has now been preponed and the present break will continue as vacation till May 31, 2020.
- Classes for 1st to 4th year BS/BS-MS students, Integrated Ph.D. and Ph.D. students for remaining 2019-20-II Semester will resume on June 1, 2020.
- The other details about the academic calendar for 1st to 4th year BS/BS-MS students, Integrated Ph.D. and Ph.D. students for remaining 2019-20-II Semester can be found in the attached file.
- Accordingly there will be some changes in schedule for 2020-21-I Semester. The updated calendar will be uploaded on the website.

Special provisions have been made for the students graduating this year (5th year BS/BS-MS, 3rd year I-PhD students and PhD students submitting the thesis)

- 5th year BS-MS and 3rd year I-PhD students will submit the thesis online by May 1, 2020. Other important dates about can be found in the attached revised calendar.
- Evaluation of MS thesis will be based on the reports submitted by students. Final MS thesis presentation will not be conducted this year. Departments will frame the policy of evaluation and inform the students accordingly.
- Though the evaluation will be done through online submission, but students are encouraged to come back and finish their pending work, if any, once the institute reopens. No-dues and other formalities related to obtaining the respective degrees will not be online, students will need complete those formalities once the institute reopens, duly consulting respective PIs.
- For the final year students taking courses (5th year BS/BS-MS and 3rd year I-PhD students), faculty members will send the reading material/ assignments/ homework etc. to the students for course completion. There will not be any formal end-semester

examinations for these students. However, students will be evaluated separately in all the courses they are enrolled in by respective instructors based on performance in mid-semester examination, quizzes, assignments, homework, take home tests etc.

• For, Ph.D. students, who wish to submit the thesis soon, PI/DPGC, can conduct the open seminar and viva-voce through video conference (skype/zoom etc.) after completing the requisite requirements and taking the necessary permission, as per the existing rules.

Summer internship of IISER Bhopal for this year stands cancelled. Further, please note that under these circumstances, no student will be allowed to proceed on summer internship abroad.

Institute will continue to remain in the lockdown mode as per the Government advisory and research students will be allowed to return to the campus after it is found safe. Unless informed by IISER Bhopal, no students should return to the campus.
