Subject: Revised Guidelines for Fellowship of Integrated Ph.D. Students


The revised guidelines for fellowship of Integrated Ph.D. students are as follows:

1. All admitted students will receive a fellowship of Rs. 10,000/- p.m. for first three years of the program.
2. If the student opts to continue with the PhD programme of the Institute, the fellowship will be enhanced to the regular PhD fellowship of JRF level (Rs 25000/- p.m.) as per MHRD norms/guidelines. They will be eligible for the enhanced fellowship from the beginning of third year of the programme.
3. The enhanced fellowship will be paid i) as arrears upon successful completion of PhD candidacy (which is the comprehensive examination) and ii) in the month of October which is two months after registering for the fourth year of the program. After this point of time, the student will receive full fellowship on regular basis.
4. The difference amount between second and third year fellowship will also be paid as arrears in the month of October i.e., two months after the registration for the fourth year of the program.
5. Arrears for enhanced amount of fellowship will not be disbursed if the student takes the MS exit option for whatever reasons.
6. Additionally, a student has to maintain a minimum CPI of 7.0 all the times to be eligible for the fellowship. Fellowship will be withdrawn as the CPI drops below 7.0. Fellowship will be re-instated as the student again achieves the minimum CPI of 7.0. Student is not eligible for any arrears for the period during which fellowship was withdrawn due to low CPI.
7. Students will be eligible for the SRF (Rs 28,000/- p.m.) upon completion of four years of the program. The JRF to SRF conversion of the student is subject to satisfactory performance in the program, which will be evaluated by a committee of experts duly proposed by the PhD supervisor of the student. This committee will submit the recommendations to the department, and the department will forward the same to the AAO.

8. The maximum tenure of fellowship for Integrated PhD students funded by Institute is 6 years. However, for externally funded students, rules as applicable by the funding agency will be followed.
9. Fellowship amount is subject to revision from time to time as the MHRD and Institute guidelines revise.
